Eligibility: 7th & 8th Grade Students.

Format: The essay should be typed, double spaced, in 12-point font (Arial or Times New Roman are preferred), with 1" margins.Do not insert identifying information such as a name or school on any sheet except the cover sheet. Do not insert graphics.

Essay Length:The essay must not exceed 750 words in length.

Cover Sheet: A cover sheet must be attached to each essay. The form is available on our website under the 4-Way Test Essay Contest tab at www.Rotary7730.org/4WayTest.php.

Original Work: The essay MUST BE ORIGINAL WORK of the student submitting the essay for competition. They MUST adhere to ALL RULES or the essay will not be accepted for review.

The following **ARE NOT PERMITTED:**

- Artificial Intelligence (AI)
- Team writing
- Parental participation
- Use of works written by other sources, even if foot-noted

Participating students will sign a pledge on the Cover Sheet stating that the essay is their original work.

Submission: Students must submit essays directly to their sponsor club for the first round of competition no later than **March 15th.**
